Work on the wildflower meadow removing creeping thistles and nettles which are slowly taking over the area.

Sunday 31st May

Heathland management, cutting back the species that can threaten the heather.

June 2015

Sunday 14th June

Another wildflower meadow task as above.

Sunday 28th June

Annual General Meeting on the heath followed by a heath task.

July 2015

Sunday 12th July

Wildflower meadow species survey and thistle removal.

Sunday 26th July

Bracken control on the heath.
