Garden update

Amazing progress has been made with all beds except the one plagued with Japanese Knotweed. All are now planted. The wet weather has meant that both weeds and grass have grown with enthusiasm but thanks to a great deal of effort outside of the regular sessions by some of our volunteers, the garden continues to look great.

The first additional session on a Tuesday afternoon went well despite the weather (a brief lull in the rain) which impacted numbers. The next additional session is this Saturday, the 25th at 10am.

To keep the grass tidy we are looking to form two teams of 3 to mow/ edge and collect grass every other fortnight, possibly Tuesday afternoons. If you think you can help please get in touch.
